Observation Training

The quality of teaching, learning and assessment is central to an institutions quality improvement and assurance processes and as such institutions need to have current and on-going confidence in the decisions and judgements made by internal observation teams. Observers need to develop; good observational skills, make accurate judgements and importantly, to be able to provide motivational support for observees in relation to their continued professional development. Leadership teams need to have confidence that judgments and gradings (where made) are aligned to the 2015 revised common inspection framework.

Landex Members can seek support for cross college observation teams through either joint / validated observations (see separate flyer) or through initial training and standardisation activities.
