

Maths and English Quality Review

From August 2015 all full-time students (those enrolling onto a study programme of at least 540 planned hours if aged 16 to 17, or at least 450 hours if aged 18) who have a grade D GCSE or equivalent in maths and/or English must be enrolled on a GCSE or approved IGCSE qualification in maths and/or English. The revised 2015 Ofsted framework highlights the link between good or better success rates on maths and English and resultant Ofsted judgements and institutions are expected to show that learners achieve well in maths and English to be deemed a good or better provider.
