Understanding the new HE quality assurance - Annual Provider Review

This workshop will provide support for Landex members in preparing for the APR, conducted by HEFCE.

A revised operating model for quality assurance in higher education will be introduced by the funding bodies of England and Northern Ireland in 2017/18, following the implementation of pilot activities in 2016/17.

The new approach is designed to be proportionate, risk-based and grounded in the context of each individual provider and its students: it will target regulatory scrutiny and activity on those issues and providers that represent greater risk to the student academic experience or to the reputation of the sector as a whole. It will also encourage continuous improvement within providers. It will remove the need for cyclical reviews by the QAA. Instead, providers will undergo an APR (or Annual Accountability Review in Northern Ireland).

The APR will be based upon analysis of performance and student satisfaction data and the governing body assurance regarding quality, resulting in a judgement about identified risks and the need for further action. It is essential, therefore, that institutions are able to collect intelligence and effectively analyse trends, to inform their governing bodies in the new quality assurance role.

This workshop will support participants in an appreciation of risk, based upon analysis of relevant data and facilitate a shared understanding of issues facing land-based universities and colleges.
