Understanding the Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF)

This workshop will provide support for Landex members preparing to participate in TEF or wishing to enhance their TEF outcome.

The TEF was introduced by the Government in 2016 with the aim of rewarding excellent teaching and learning offered by higher education providers.

The specification for the TEF has been subject to consultation with the higher education sector and the Framework is being phased in, using a piloted approach, based on a set of metrics and a supporting contextual statement, submitted by the institution, for consideration by independent assessors and a panel, resulting in outcomes of gold, silver or bronze for participating providers. These outcomes will, in the future, inform differentiated tuition fees.

Understanding the aspirations and processes of the TEF will support institutions in preparing their submissions, and this workshop will focus upon understanding the data used to provide the relevant metrics and how this can inform contextual statements. Participants will be able to share their experiences of TEF and consider how their particular issues can be addressed.
